The aim of the Master Class is to look at complex clinical scenarios, where the diagnosis and management of ASC is not obvious.

- Undiagnosed ASC : How many times have we considered a diagnosis of ASC in an adult with behavioural disinhibition?**
- What do we tell parents when we break the news?**
- How do we answer questions about heritability?**
- Is there a link between gender dysphoria and ASC?**
- How do we decide and help parents choose relevant therapies among all that are on offer, to suit an individual across the lifespan?**

 - ii. how to evaluate authenticity within the range of treatment modalities and**
 - iii. roles of different therapists.**
- **What our roles can be beyond diagnosis and pharmacological treatments.**
- **A rights-based approach and setting up services as an independent clinician.**
